

THOMPSON VILLAGE APPRAISAL 2016

Summary of the Results

Thompson Village Appraisal 2016

161 appraisals were given out and 145 returned – this represents a little over a 90% return.

Of the returned forms 4 were blank and one contained no information regarding number in household, age and sex and therefore it was not possible to enter the information that was provided on those parts of the appraisal that were completed, into the program – "The computer said no"!

The data from the remaining 140 responses was entered on to the computer and the data automatically analysed.

Answers to the Household section, questions 1-13 were given by one person. This is reflected by all questions having a total of 140 respondents regardless of whether or not the questions were answered.

Answers to the Personal section, questions 14-81 were available to all aged 11 or over in question 2. The number of respondents to each question is noted next to the question number. Please note that some questions allowed respondents to give multiple responses and so the total number of responses is, some cases greater than the number of respondents.

Question 71 required a comment only response and was recorded by, but not analysed by, the program. Instead all the were responses analysed by "hand", divided into general topics and the number of responses for each topic noted. There were 88 respondents to this question, some giving comments on more than one topic, all were noted and registered in the appropriate topic. A list off all comments by topic is available but not included here.

There is a disparity between the numbers in question 2 and 14. This is brought about by some people not answering question 14 or by answering it in an unusable form ie. Ticks for male and female in the same column. Similarly, the disparity between 14 and 15 is bought about by ticks in the same column for question 14 but where both were in the same age band for question 15. Some respondents ticked neither question14 or 15 but continued to fill in the rest of the form, in these cases, as questions 1 and 2 had been answered the computer allowed entry of the data.

Another area of problem was where a multiple choice question required a number but was answered with a tick. In these cases, the data was not entered into the program.
