Mr Johnson (Chairman) opened the meeting & explained that the Bungalow was to be built to re-house Mr & Mrs Wheeler who will have to leave No 2 Avey House after 50 years. The meeting was then closed to enable Public comments. Several spoke against the Bungalow because:

1 Outside Building Envelope

2 Subject to flooding

3 Not necessary as other temporary accommodation

could be found for Mr & Mrs Wheeler even a Mobile Home as they could be re-housed in the new Houses.

4 Mr May wished to buy the plot to add value to his house.

The meeting was re-convened & the Planning Committee decided not to object to No 1 but to object to No 2 being outside the Envelope.
