1. To discuss a new planning application **3PL/2018/1178/HOU & 3PL/2018/1179/LB**
Applicant: R & K Wolstenholme, College Farm
Description of works: Proposals for cow barn refurbishment and alterations for games room and annex for auxiliary living space to College Farm.

All councillors were in favour of the application and agreed it would be an improvement to the existing building. There were some concerns regards the possibility of an increased noise level from weddings and music festivals and it was hoped that the annex would not be sold off.

A meeting of the Parish Council was held on Monday 22 October 2018 to discuss planning applications 3PL/2018/1178/HOU and 3PL/2018/1179/LB. It was viewed that a dilapidated building was being brought back to life and to use. The PC would however like it noted: they hoped the annex would remain as part of the house and couldn't be sold as a separate dwelling in the future.
