Information for Photographers

### Introduction

Most of the mixed-media exhibitions we have held in the Dragonfly Gallery since it opened in 2006, have included some photography, often of Norfolk events or landscapes, and the Breckland Photography Competition, now held annually, produces some stunning work.

So this year, our tenth anniversary year, the Wayland Partnership plans to dedicate one of the exhibitions to be held in the Dragonfly Gallery entirely to photographs of Norfolk. *'The Magic of Norfolk'* will be held from June 26<sup>th</sup> to July 3<sup>rd</sup> and will be open to all who love taking photographs and who love and appreciate Norfolk



### How to enter

Anyone wishing to submit their photographs for inclusion in the *Magic of Norfolk* exhibition should contact the Wayland Partnership (details below) for an entry form. In the first instance you will need to give us some basic information and provide some samples of your work. The form will tell you that the Gallery's hanging fees are currently £2.25 per item and commission is 20% of sales (these are to cover Gallery costs) and invite you to submit up to six items.

Once your work has been accepted for the exhibition, you will be asked to provide titles and prices for your work and information about any small sales items such as greetings cards you may have for sale. The deadline for entries is May 10th

During Exhibitions and throughout the Visitor season the Gallery is staffed by our Team of dedicated volunteers who also run the Tourist Information Centre.



### Who can enter?

This exhibition is not a competition nor is it in anyway linked to the Breckland Photography Competition. Just as with our other exhibitions, anyone, whether professional, semi-professional or amateur may enter their work. If the exhibition is over-subscribed, as they generally are, then the Partnership Team will make a selection to create a high-quality, balanced display that the public will enjoy.

### What can be entered?

Any photograph taken in the county of Norfolk that celebrates its landscape, buildings, events, seasons, flora and fauna etc. Photographs may be in colour or black and white, should be framed and should have been taken fairly recently.
